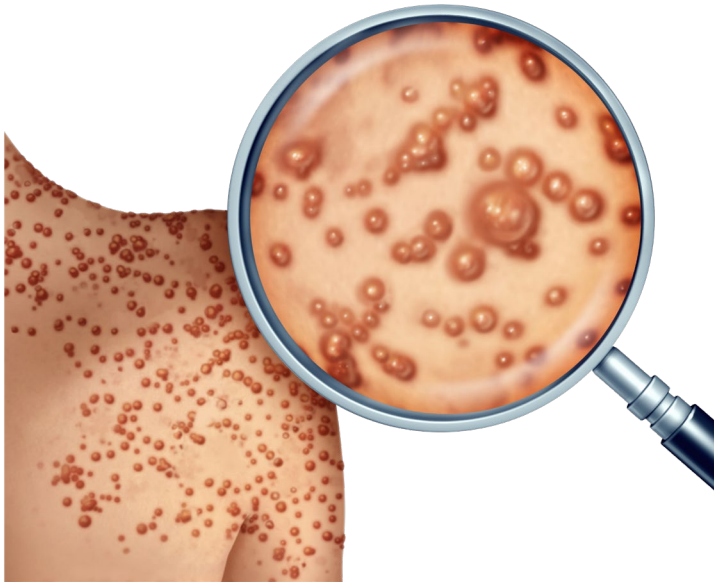


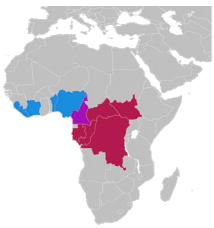
Monkeypox

Look out for the signs



Monkeypox is a virus infection that causes

- * Headache
- * Fever (over 38.5°)
- * Swollen glands
- * Aches and weakness
- * Rash and blisters



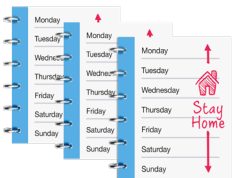
Monkeypox is quite rare outside parts of Africa where it is spread by wild animals



Now people in other countries are also catching monkeypox



The virus is spread by touching an infected person or their clothes, bedding or towels



If you get monkeypox you must stay home and isolate for 3 weeks



Call 111 or your GP if you have a rash with blisters

Say if you have just been to west Africa or had contact with someone with monkeypox
